Who Does the Team Serve?

- O Individuals in Seneca County who overdose and are registered with a police report or referred by a stakeholder.
- O Individuals in Seneca County with mental health needs who are at risk for decompensation, not engaged in services and/or in need of support from the team. Referred by the treatment agency and other stakeholders.
- O Outreach is done on Mondays and Thursdays and then follow up services as needed.

Workshop Title: **Addressing Stigma** Through the Health Stigma and Discrimination Framework: **Experiences** of Ashtabula, Fairfield, Sandusky, and Seneca Counties.

This workshop will cover how funding through HRSA's Rural Communities Opioid Response Program allowed a consortium of four Ohio rural and Appalachian communities to use the Health Stigma and Discrimination Framework (HSDF; Stangl, at al., 2019) to understand, measure, and address stigma associated with opioid use and opioid use disorder treatment. The workshop will focus on how the consortium was able to use the HSDF to develop an innovative community wide survey to measure driver, facilitators, and outcomes of stigma associated with opioid use. The survey was then fielded by Gallup in each of the four communities in the consortium. Results from the survey will be presented as well as how those results are being used in each community to address and reduce stigma associated with opioid use and treatment. The workshop will share implementation approaches as well as intersections at the community level with ongoing harm reduction.



Stigma Survey: Analysis and Next Steps

- Finishing Excel-based reporting templates (MH & SUD) to share out with the COP-RCORP Consortium
- Tentative timeline: 1-2 weeks to get that out
- Next steps:
 - Re-convening the stigma workgroup
 - Local consortia review of results
 - COP-RCORP Consortium review of results (special meeting)
 - Determining how to share results with communities, OhioMHAS, and across state.
 - Pivot into strategy selection and implementation
 - Approximately \$8,000 is left in the budget from the survey to support implementation + unspent travel funding \$4,500)


