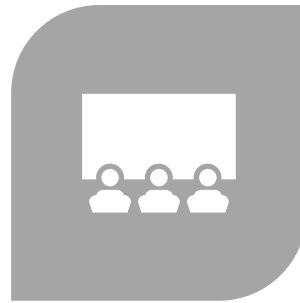

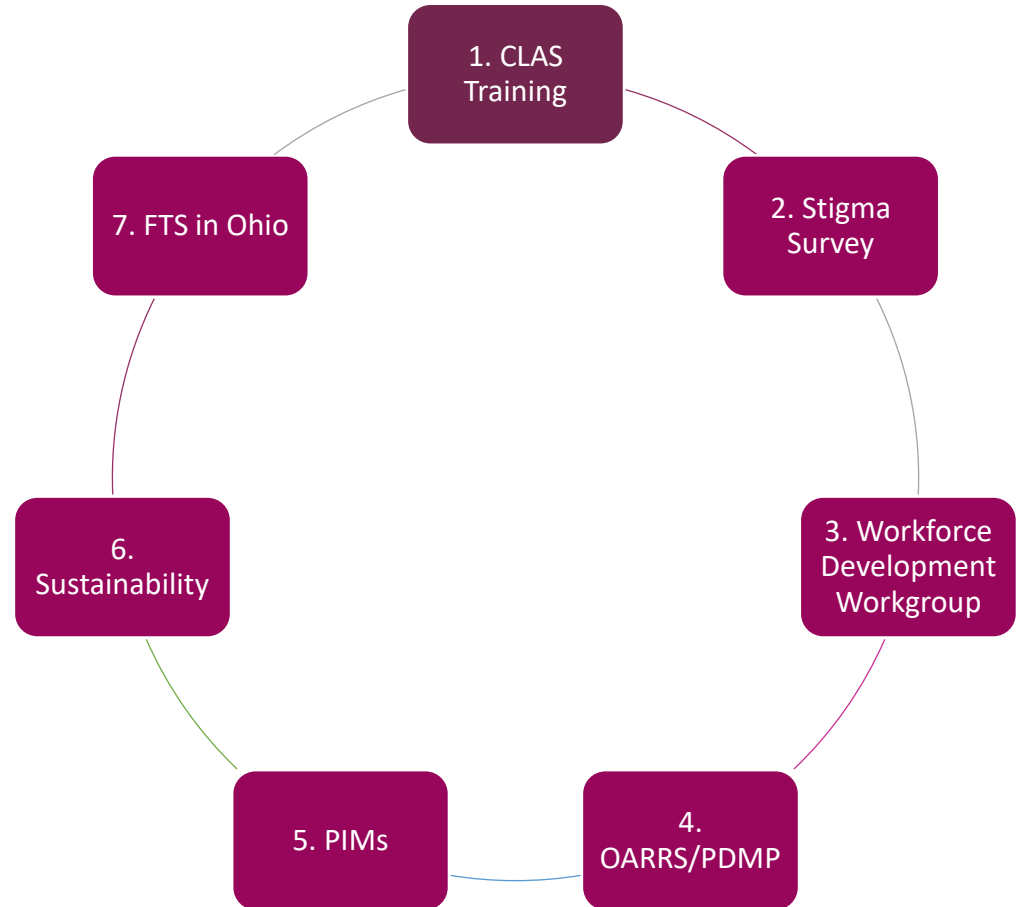

Revises law governing distribution and access to naloxone and fentanyl testing strips

Has received 4 hearings in Senate Health Committee; no vote yet

If voted out of committee and passed by Senate, will move to House for additional hearings

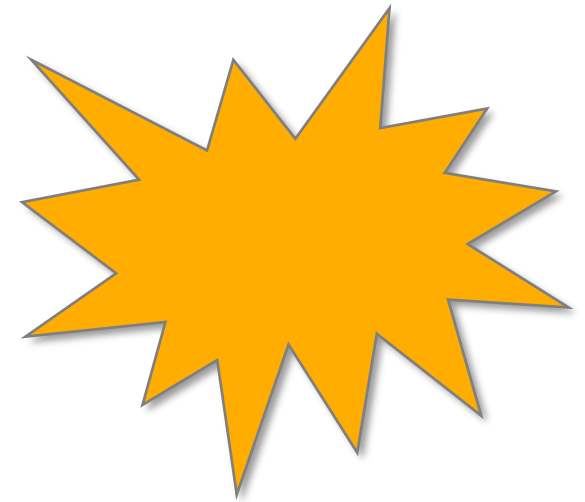
